**Pre-amble;**

The chairperson called the meeting to order after word of prayer from Hamida Ismael at 10:05AM.

The minutes of the previous meeting were proposed and confirmed by Nelson Mandela—as being the true matters discussed, then adapted by the whole committee.

**MIN 4. MHN/NGCDF/11/10/2021 – PROJECT PROPOSAL FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2021/2022.**

The chairperson reminded members that the constituency was late with the project proposal for the financial year 2021/22. The chairperson informed members that the total allocation for the financial year 2021/2022 is Kshs. 137,088,879.31. He handed over to the Fund Account Manager to make further clarification on the allocation to the members.

Fund Account Manager served every member with a copy of the Board circulation concerning submission of constituency project proposal for the financial year 2021/2022. He further gave the summary of the allocation as follows;




