He pointed out that the meeting was crucial as it involves approval of proposed projects for the financial year 2018/2019 that had been proposed by the constituents during the ward meetings held in 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> December, 2017.

#### MINUTE -02/19/11/2018: READING AND CONFIRMATION OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

The secretary read through the minutes of the previous meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2018. After scrutiny by the members they were proposed to be adopted as true records of the meeting by Mr. James Goga and seconded by Ms. Iddah Seko

#### MINUTE -03/19/11/2018: MATTERS ARISING

#### MINUTE -04/19/11/2018: PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION OF FINANCIAL YEAR 2018/2019 PROPOSAL GUIDELINES

The Fund Account Manager presented to the meeting a circular from the NG-CDF Board ref no. NG-CDFB/CIRCULARS Vol. II (008) dated 30<sup>th</sup> October, 2018 spelling out the guidelines on Preparation and Submission of Financial Year 2018/2019 Proposal. Where each constituency has been allocated Kshs 109,040,875.52 In drawing the financial year 2018/2019 budget proposals the NG-CDFCs attention have been drawn to the under listed requirements.


#### **Basis of Identification of Project Proposals.**

NG- CDF committees are required to align their project proposals with the Government development policy as outlined in the big Four Agenda and vision 2030

#### **Eligible Projects under the Act**

As per the section 24 of the NG-CDF Act as amended in 2016.

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Eligible projects are only those that are in respect of works and services falling within the functions of the National Government under the constitution, which must be community based in order to ensure the benefits are available to a widespread cross section of the inhabitants of a particular area. In addition, eligible projects shall be those that foster sustainable development, promote human dignity and protection of the marginalised as per Article 10 of the Constitution that outlines national values and principles of governance.

Constituency Committees shall be expected to exclude project proposals that fail to meet eligibility criteria for NG-CDF funding such as:

- Projects supporting political bodies or political activities
- Projects supporting religious bodies or religious activities
- Recurrent costs of a completed project
- Personal awards with the exception of social security programme and education bursary
- Projects targeting a specific club or group of people to the exclusion of others
- Projects falling under devolved functions as outlined in the fourth Schedule of the Constitution.

### **Project Proposals Co-Funded with other Agencies**

As provided in the section 49 of the NG-CDF Act, the board may consider part funding of a project financed from sources other than the fund so long as the other financiers or donors of that project have no objection and provided that the part funding for the project availed pursuant to this Act shall go to a defined in the allocation is completed with the funds allocated under the act.

Before preparing such project proposals, NG-CDFs shall be expected to first enter into a formal agreement with providers of counterpart funding, clearly indicating the phase to be financed by each party.

### **Completion of On-Going Projects before Embarking on New Ones.**

In order to enhance prudence in use of scarce resources as outlined in Article 201 of the constitution, the Board Urges Constituencies to focus on completion of ongoing projects before embarking on new ones. Towards this end, management in line with section 46 (2) of the NG-CDF Act directed fund Account Managers to take stock of all ongoing projects and submit a detailed report encompassing estimated cost of

completion of an entire project or defined phase that can be put to a productive use upon completion. NG-CDF Committees are therefore advised to utilise the report while preparing 2018/2019 project proposals with view to ensuring that the ongoing projects are allocated adequate funds before new projects are prioritised.

### **Labelling/Branding of Constituency Projects.**

Constituency Committees are further required to ensure that cost of the projects labelling/branding is incorporated in the bill of quantities for each project. This will ensure that constituencies do not face the need to allocate additional funds towards labelling of completed projects in subsequent financial years.

While labelling completed projects, NG-CDFs shall adhere to the Boards guidelines on labelling/branding of projects.

### **Adherence to Statutory Ceilings**

While preparing project proposals, NG-CDFs are required to adhere to the statutory ceilings of projects as provided for in the NG-CDF Act;

### **Declaration of Appropriation in Aid**

Further to the board circular Ref: NGCDF BOARDS/ ACCOUNTS GENERAL/2017/ VOL1/02 dated 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2017. Constituencies are reminded to comply with Section 12(9) and 36(6) of the NG-CDF Act by ensuring that all accruals are declared as part of the subsequent year's constituency Fund.

The information shall be indicated in the prescribed format earlier sent to Fund Managers.

### **Clearance of the Outstanding Issues with Regard to Previous Financial Years Project Proposals**

It has been observed that some constituencies are yet to address board's requirements to facilitate approval and release of funds for pending project proposals identified in the previous Financial Years.

Fund Account Managers are required to prioritise clearance of such outstanding issues as a prerequisite for processing requisition for funds for the 2018/2019 Financial Year.
