The meeting was called to order by the chairman at 11:00 Am followed with an opening prayer from Evalina Dunga.

The previous minutes were read by the secretary then members confirmed them as true record of the previous meeting deliberations having been proposed by Alfred Oretto and seconded by Alice Ojowi

MIN: 011 SSNGCDFC / SEPTEMBER/2021/2022: MATTERS ARISING FROM THE PREVIOUS MINUTES

There were no matters arising

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The NG-CDF Committee made the following deliberations to ensure compliance with the circular Rep. NG-CDFB/CEO/BOARD/CHIEF CLARIS Vol. II (2020) dated 26th August 2021 on call for submission of Constituency projects proposals for the 2021/2022 financial year.

1. The projects had been identified through consultative forums.
2. The projects proposed were all eligible under the NG-CDF Act, 2015 as amended in 2016.
3. The projects proposed had defined unit or part thereof or phase.
4. Preference was given to completion of ongoing projects.
5. Allocation of funds to Sports and Environmental projects. The committee definitively prioritized on projects falling under education and security sectors and resolved to allocate only Kshs. 300,000.00 and Kshs. 400,000.00 for constituency Sports, Tournament and environment project respectively in order to appreciate the importance of role of sports and environmental conservation, noting that the facilities were developed.
6. Priority in allocations to projects. The committee resolved to allocate varying amounts to projects with the same activities because of difference in soil types and ground nature of various project sites in addition some projects were located at places with logistical challenges causing building materials cost and incidental costs to shoot above others.
7. The committee resolved to allocate adequate funds to new projects to ensure that they were implemented to completion in the shortest period possible for service delivery enhancement.
8. Proposed security surveillance (Patrol) speed boat for Kiawa Beach Management Unit. The committee agreed that the office of the Deputy County Commissioner for Suba Sub County was to supervise the operation of the security boat and officially own the facilities to ensure their sustainability.

While concluding the above deliberations, the committee recommended that the projects proposed for 2021/2022 financial year as tabulated below be submitted to the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Board for approval and funding therefor.

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

0.0 Introduction or Background

0.1 About NG CDF

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) formerly Constituencies Development Fund (CDF), is a fund established in 2003 through an Act of Parliament, the CDF Act 2003. The Act was later reviewed by the CDF (Amendment) Act 2007, and repealed by CDF Act, 2013 which was subsequently succeeded by the current NG-CDF (Amendment) Act 2016.

The Fund is domiciled within The National Treasury and Ministry of Planning.

The main purpose of the Fund is to enhance infrastructural and socio-economic development at the grass root level in order to reduce poverty by dedicating a minimum of two and half per cent (2.5%) of all National Government's share of annual revenue towards community projects identified at constituency level by the communities.

0.2 About Suba South Constituency

Suba South is an electoral Constituency IEBC Code number 252 in Kenya within Homa Bay County number 043 with a population of approximately 111,409 and 32,440 registered voters. The constituency is composed of the following four County Assembly wards; Kaksingri West, Ruma Kaksingri East, Gwassi North and Gwassi South. It was formerly called Gwassi Constituency and due to court ruling the name changed to Suba Constituency and Suba South Constituency during 2013 and 2017 General Elections respectively.

The allocation for financial year 2020/2021 as tabulated by the NG-CDF Board was Ksh. 137,088,879.31. Suba South NG-CDF is managed by a Committee comprising of eight members representing various categories within the constituency together with the Deputy County Commissioner who represents the national government and the Fund Account Manager who is an officer seconded to the constituency by the NG-CDF board.

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3.5 Comments by TAM on the nature of projects in respect to NG-CDF Act

The Fund Account Manager informed the meeting that NG-CDF Act as amended in 2016 was aligned with the Constitution of Kenya 2010, more specifically in compliance with the principles of transparency and accountability, separation of powers, and participation of the people. He briefed the meeting that NG-CDF were only mandated to fund projects falling within education and security sectors and that projects to be funded under the Act were to be Community based in order to ensure that the prospective benefits are available to a widespread cross section of the inhabitants of the area. In addition he mentioned that any funding under the Act was to be for a complete project or a defined phase of a project, he concluded by saying that recurrent costs of the projects were not fundable by NG-CDF.

3.6 Comments by Chairman on bursary and environment

The NGCDFC chairman told the meeting that the committee was allowed to allocate between 25% - 35% and 2% of the total constituency allocation to bursary fund/Mocks /CAT and environmental activities respectively.

On bursary, he reminded the meeting that the location bursary committees were to conduct vetting of bursary's applications and forward the recommended names to the NGCDFC for consideration /approval.

He concluded by informing the meeting that it was the government's environmental policy that each and every development initiative should incorporate an environmental activity/project to ensure environmental conservation and sustainability within the areas of operation.
