AWENDO NG-CDFC: MIN 03/S/01/2024: MATTERS ARISING

There was no matters arising

AWENDO NG-CDFC: MIN 04/S/01/2024 MATCHING FUND FOR INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT OF JSS.

Fund Account Manager informed the members that they had a successful meeting on 8th November 2023 tabled the resolution agreed between the Deputy county commissioner, Fund Account Manager and the sub county director of education concerning the junior secondary schools to be funded through the joint matching fund between the Ministry of Education and the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Board. He informed members that Awendo was allocated Kshs 12,298,533 from the Ministry of Education. This was to be matched with same amount from NGCDF of Kshs 12,298,533. The total amount being Kshs 24,597,066. A member observed that so far the ministry of education has not released circular to the sub county indicating the modality of how the subject matter would be implemented. Members had a lengthy discussion and the following criteria were adopted while identify the projects.

1. At least one science laboratory in one primary school offering junior Secondary school programme.
2. Equitable distribution of JSS projects across within the constituency
3. School population.
4. Infrastructure status of the primary school.
5. population distribution and Distance between the affected primary schools

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AWENDO NG-CDFC: MIN 06/8/01/2024: REALIGNMENT OF CONSTITUENCIES PROJECT PROPOSALS

Fund Account Manager tabled to members both the Board circular dated 4th January 2024 and the recently enacted National Government Constituencies Development Fund (Amendment) Act 2023 which introduces fundamental changes that have implications on the project fundable under the Act. The committee in their deliberation agreed to make amendment in the proposal by dropping sports and COC as per the amendment and introduces the climatic change under environment. They also agreed to construct ICT hub at Rabuor Kogelo primary school. The school management has been notified to provide land to that effect. The committee in their deliberation agreed to construct a new ICT hub because The Awendo National Library which was constructed by the NG-CDFC Awendo, its functions was transferred to County Government of Migori.

AWENDO NG-CDFC:MIN 08/8/01/2024: PROJECT PROPOSAL 2023/2024

The NG-CDFC chairman took the members through NG-CDF Act 2015 concerning preparation of the budget proposal to be submitted to the NG-CDF Board by Fund Account Manager. The members were informed that the Constituency 2023/2024 financial year allocation is Kshs.166, 593,720 and Kshs. 12,298,533 for Infrastructural Development in Junior Secondary Schools from the Ministry of Education making a total budget of Kshs. 178,892,253. Members agreed to give the ongoing projects a first priority and the balance to be distributed to the projects which were considered from the ward meetings.

He asked members to ensure that all projects committed previously and has so far been completed be given enough funds that can make them reach a usable state. He however reiterated that the fund for financial year 2023/2024 might not be enough to enable them factor in the proposed flagship projects in each ward. He also updated members on the issue of the court case for Awendo Police Headquarters that is not yet concluded therefore the project still cannot be funded.

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The NG-Constituency Development Act 2015 stipulates in part 5 section 27 subsection 1 and 2 that the chairperson of the NG -CDFC shall, within the first year of the commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency.

The NG-CDFC shall then deliberate on project proposals from all the wards in the constituency and any other projects which the Constituency Committee considers beneficial to the constituency, including joint projects with other constituencies, consider the national development plans and policies and the constituency strategic development plan, and identify a list of priority projects, both immediate and long term, out of which the list of projects to be submitted in accordance with the Act shall be drawn from.

Citizen participation in project planning, management and implementation requires the involvement of concerned stakeholders. This includes identifying public concerns and values and developing a broad consensus on planned initiatives. It is also about utilizing the vast amount of information and knowledge that stakeholders hold to find workable, efficient and sustainable solutions.

Public participation encompasses a range of procedures and methods designed to consult, involve, and inform the public to allow those that would be potentially affected by a decision or policy to have input into the process. Community participation motivates the stakeholders to work together, recognize the benefits of their involvement and own the projects in their localities. Stakeholders play a central role in setting up priorities and objectives of development.

Initiatives in order to ensure relevance and appropriateness. It is important that all stakeholders are involved in the development of projects and not just direct beneficiaries of an initiative.

1.1 ABOUT NG-CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was established under the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act, 2003, amended in 2007 and repealed by the CDF Act of 2013. In 2015, the CDF Act of 2013 was declared unconstitutional and a new Act was enacted in 2015, being the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, 2015. The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is under the Ministry of Devolution and Planning.

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The Constituency Development Fund (CDF) was introduced in Kenya in 2003 with the passage of the CDF Act 2003 by the 9th Parliament of Kenya which was repealed in 2013 by the CDF Act 2013. The CDF Act provides that the government set aside at least 2.5% of its ordinary revenue for disbursement under the CDF program.

The fund was designed to support constituency-level, grass-root development projects. It was aimed to achieve equitable distribution of development resources across regions and to control imbalances in regional development brought about by partisan politics. It targeted all constituency-level development projects, particularly those aiming to combat poverty at the grassroots and entrench equitable distribution of development.

The objective of the Fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government Development Agenda at the constituency level.

The CDF program has facilitated the putting up of new water systems, health and education facilities in all parts of the country, including remote areas that were usually overlooked during funds allocation in national budgets.

The enactment of the CDF Act 2013 was mainly aimed to ensure that the law governing CDF is aligned to the Constitution of Kenya 2010, specifically in compliance with the principles of:

- Transparency and accountability,
- Separation of powers; and
- Participation of the people.

The new law was also aimed to align the operations of the Fund to the new devolved government structure.

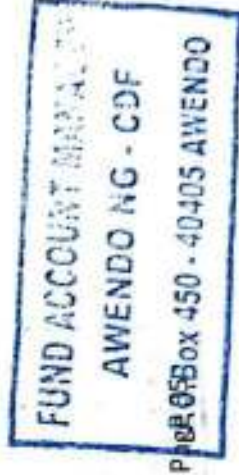

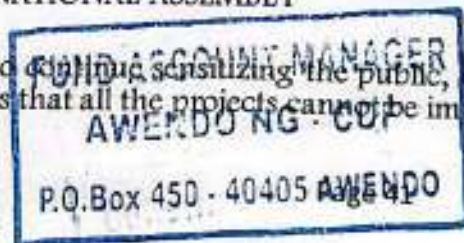

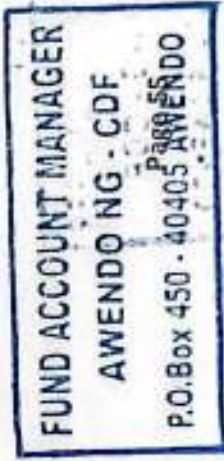
