Introduction or Background

About NG-CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was established through an Act of the Kenyan Parliament in the Year 2003 and in the year 2015 the whole Act was repealed giving birth to the National Government Constituency Development Fund Act. The Fund is distributed to each of the 290 Parliamentary Constituencies for the purposes of development and in particular the fight against poverty at Constituency level.

The fund is allocated a minimum of 2.5% of all Government ordinary Revenue collected in every financial year for distribution by the NG-CDF Board to each of the 290 Constituencies Equally.

About Suna East

Suna East constituency is a constituency in Migori county and it comprises of four wards i.e. Suna Central Ward, Kakrao Ward, God Jope Ward and Kwa Ward. It has a total of 10 locations namely Upper Suna, Kwa, Suna Rabuor, God Jope, Suna East, Suna Central, Ngege, Suna Nyabisawa, Otacho and Suna Upper

The Suna East Constituency Development Fund Committee is currently composed of 10 members each drawn from a specific group of the community that is 1 male rep, 1 female rep, 1 male youth rep, 1 female youth rep, 1 person living with disability, 1 constituency office representative and 1 co-opted member. The Deputy County Commissioner and the NG-CDF Fund Account Manager. The role of the CDF Committee is to collect proposals for Projects from the Community at the grassroots, prioritize the projects for funding and subsequently disburse funds to these projects and Monitor and Evaluate their Implementation to ensure they achieve the stated objectives of the Fund.

In the Financial Year (2021/2022) the constituency is to receive Ksh. 137,088,879.00
