INTRODUCTION

The NG-Constituency Development Act 2015 as amended in 2022 stipulates in part 5 section 27 subsection 1 and 2 that the chairperson of the NG-CDFC shall, within the first year of the commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every wardin the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency.

The NG-CDFC shall then deliberate on project proposals from all the wards in the constituency and any other projects which the Constituency Committee considers beneficial to the constituency, including joint projects with other constituencies, consider the national development plans and policies and the constituency strategic development plan, and identify a list of priority projects, both immediate and long term, out of which the list of projects to be submitted in accordance with the Act shall be drawn from.

Citizen participation in project planning, management and implementation planning requires the involvement of concerned stakeholders. This includes identifying public concerns and values and developing a broad consensus on planned initiatives. It is also about utilizing the vast amount of information and knowledge that stakeholders hold to find workable, efficient and sustainable solutions.

Public participation encompasses a range of procedures and methods designed to consult, involve, and inform the public to allow those that would be potentially affected by a decision or policy to have input into the process. Community participation motivates the stakeholders to work together, recognize the benefits of their involvement and own the projects in their localities.

Stakeholders play a central role in setting up priorities and objectives of development Initiatives in order to ensure relevance and appropriateness. It is important that all stakeholders are involved in the development of projects and not just direct beneficiaries of an initiative.

ABOUT NG-CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was established under the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act, 2003, amended in 2007 and repealed by the CDF Act of 2013. In 2015, the CDF Act of 2013 was declared unconstitutional and a new Act was enacted in 2015, being the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, NG~CDF Act,

2015. The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is under the Ministry of Devolution and Planning.

The Constituency Development Fund (CDF) was introduced in Kenya in 2003 with the passage of the CDF Act 2003 by the 9th Parliament of Kenya which was repealed in 2013 by the CDF Act 2013. The CDF Act provides that the government set aside at least 2.5% of its ordinary revenue for disbursement under the CDF program.

The fund was designed to support constituency-level, grass-root development projects. It was aimed to achieve equitable distribution of development resources across regions and to control imbalances in regional development brought about by partisan politics. It targeted all constituency-level development projects, particularly those aiming to combat poverty at the grassroots and entrench equitable distribution of development.

The objective of the Fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government Development Agenda at the constituency level.

The CDF program has facilitated the putting up of new water systems, health and education facilities in all parts of the country, including remote areas that were usually overlooked during funds allocation in national budgets.

ABOUT BOBASI NG-CDF

Bobasi constituency is geographically located in Kisii County. The constituency borders with the two Nyaribari constituencies, Chache and Borabu to the North, Narok County to the South; Bomachoge Chache and Bomachoge Borabu to the West/South and Bonchari constituency to the Northwest.

It lies between the latitude 00.33 and 101 south of equator and longitude 345'38" and 352 seats of Greenwich Mean Time. It covers an area of 240.4km2. The constituency has a population of 223,000 (Kenya census 2019) and has a population density of 929 persons per square kilometer.

The constituency has Eight (8) wards namely: Bassi Chache, Masige East, Masige West, Bassi Boitangare, Sameta Mokwerero, Nyacheki, Bogetaorio and Bassi Central. The administration policy has maintained the two (2) divisions: Sameta and Nyamache.

The constituency is endowed with a highland equatorial climate giving it a bimodal rainfall with an average of 1.500MM of rainfall. The long rains come between March and June; the short rains start in September and end in November each year. There is a short spell of drought in the months of January and February. The temperature ranges between 22 degrees Celsius to 32 degree Celsius-highly 16 degrees Celsius and 21 degrees Celsius low. The plentiful rainfall accompanied by temperate temperatures are really suitable for growing all types of crops such as tea, coffee and food crops such as maize, beans, wimbi etc. However, the only bad side of the heavy rains is that it makes roads impassable rendering accessibility to market by farmers and business people impossible.

5TH JANUARY 2023 - NYACHEKI AND BASSI BOGETAORIO WARDS

Two separate meetings were held on 5th January 2023 one at Nyacheki Market and another at Riankuru Marketstarting 10.31Am and 1.48 Pm respectively.

The meetings were attended by the CDFC members, Constituency Office Manager, Chiefs and assistant chiefs and the community members from the wards.

Both occasions were graced by the NG-CDF Bobasi Constituency. The projects identified in the wards were sub-divided into various sectors, given priorities and catered for in the budget proposal for this financial year. Information on this is also kept in the file in our office.

Despite low turnouts, the exercises were successfully conducted and the committee ensured that the regional representation in every ward was well catered for.

COMMENTS BY THE CONSTITUENCY OFFICE MANAGER

In his common message, the FAM informed the community members that it was a requirement under the Kenyan constitution of 2010 for public participation and that the NG-CDF Act 2015 requires that the ward meetings are held to give the public a chance to participate in developmental issues in the constituency.

He requested the area Chief to control the exercise of collecting views from his people and it was agreed that chances be given to one person at a time.

The FAM informed the meeting on the nature of eligible projects fundable by NG-CDF as community based to ensure that the prospective benefits are available to a widespread cross-section of the inhabitants of a particular area and those in respect of works and services falling within the functions of the National Government under the constitution.

Further to this he also highlighted the ineligible projects which include: Projects supporting religious bodies or religious activities, projects supporting political bodies or political activities, recurrent costs of a completed projects, personal projects, private projects and projects targeting a specific club or group of people to the exclusion of others.

II(033) dated 15th December 2022 from the Board on preparation and submission of 2022/2023 FY project proposal. Members then, deliberated extensively on various projects in the Ward Report with keen consideration to ongoing projects.

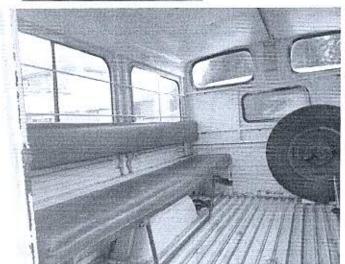

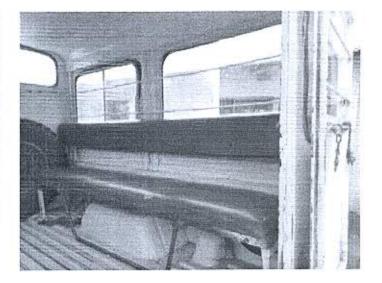
Constituency Motor Vehicle - Annex XVI
