#### MIN. 1/20/09/2021 PRELIMINARIES


The chairman called the meeting to order at 10.00 am and the meeting started with a word of prayer from Mr. Naftal Omare. Thereafter, the chairman welcomed all members and wished them a fruitful deliberation.

## MIN. 2/20/09/2021 READING AND CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2021 were read by the secretary and were proposed as true reflection of the previous deliberations by Mr. Mathew Ondieki and seconded by Mr. Otucho Doctor.

#### MIN. 3/20/09/2021 MATTERS ARISING

A concern was raised on the proposed project funds for the construction of St. Daniels Riontweka Secondary School four classrooms which was Kshs. 2,000,000 to do the erection and skeleton project funds were raised to Kshs. 2,900,000 due to addition of Administration block



and the current inflation, hence therefore additional funding will be required to complete the institution.

#### MIN. 4/20/09/2021 COMPILATION OF WARD REPORT

The chairman updated members on the recently conducted public participation ward report that was aimed at soliciting the priority projects from the public to be included in the 2021/2022 financial year project proposal. The members tentatively perused through the compiled report, discussed and agreed to give priority to projects which are more in need.

### MIN. 5/20/09/2021 PREPARATION OF THE 2021/2022 FY PROJECT PROPOSAL

The FAM took the members through the entire circular; NG-CDFB/CIRCULARS VOL. 2 (008) from the Board on preparation and submission of 2021/2022 FY project proposal. Members then, deliberated extensively on various projects in the Ward Report with keen consideration to ongoing projects. It was also observed that some projects were not included in the existing ongoing projects report submitted to the Board hence they have been included in the amended report. The estimates to Some of the projects in the ongoing list have since been altered as follows;

- i. Bishop Mugendi Nyakegogi Secondary School The project was done through co-funding by NG-CDF and the school community for the construction of a girls' dormitory. NG-CDF was to fund the project to a tune of Kshs. 4,000,000; an amount that has since been paid to completion.
- ii. Isena mixed secondary school The project was done through co-funding by NG-CDF and the school community for the construction of a 150 capacity dormitory. The project was initially allocated 1,000,000 in the 2018/2019 FY. The project is still under construction and NG-CDFC wishes to allocate an additional 1,500,000 this financial year 2021/2022 for its completion by walling of 1st floor, roofing, fixing of steel doors and windows, plastering and painting.
- iii. Bokini Banto primary school the project was initially estimated at Kshs. 2,400,000 for the construction of a 200 capacity social hall. It was allocated Kshs. 1,400,000 in the 2015/2016 FY. On review of the cost estimates for the remaining works, it was observed that the project can be completed by an additional kshs. 500,000 for fixing of steel doors and windows, plastering and painting.
- iv. Nyoera primary school NG-CDFC noted that the Ongoing report erroneously indicated that there has been an ongoing project for construction of 4 classrooms whereas the project has been funded twice; 2017/2018 FY the project was allocated Ksh 600,000 for reroofing of construction of 2018/2019 FY the project was allocated Ksh 400,000 for reroofing BOBASI



- of 5 classrooms. Thus, the current allocation of Kshs. 500,000 is meant for renovation of  $5_{\phi}$  classrooms by roofing, plastering, fixing of steel doors and windows.
- v. Nyangoso SDA primary school the project was initially estimated at Kshs. 4,000,000 for the construction of a 100 capacity library. It was allocated Kshs. 750,000 in the 2014/2015 FY. On review of the cost estimates for the remaining works, it was observed that the project can be completed by an additional kshs. 2,500,000 for ground floor walling, fixing of ring beam, slabbing, roofing, fixing of steel doors and windows, plastering and painting to completion.

Members were informed that all constituencies were allocated equal amount of Kshs. 137,088,879. The Committee then resolved to fund the projects as tabulated below, and asked the Fund Account Manager to expedite the submission of the proposals to the Board.

#### INLIKODUCTION

The NG-Constituency Development Act 2015 stipulates in part 5 section 27 subsection I and 2 that the chairperson of the NG-CDFC shall, within the first year of the commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency.

The Constituency Development Fund (CDF) was introduced in Kenya in 2003 with the passage of the CDF Act 2003 by the 9th Parliament of Kenya which was repealed in 2013 by the CDF Act 2013. The CDF Act provides that the government set aside at least 2.5% of its ordinary revenue for disbursement under the CDF program.

The fund was designed to support constituency-level, grass-root development projects. It was aimed to achieve equitable distribution of development resources across regions and to control imbalances in regional development brought about by partisan politics. It targeted all constituency-level development projects, particularly those aiming to combat poverty at the grassroots and entrench equitable distribution of development.

The objective of the Fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government Development Agenda at the constituency level.

The CDF program has facilitated the putting up of new water systems, health and education facilities in all parts of the country, including remote areas that were usually overlooked during funds allocation in national budgets.

#### ABOUT BOBASI NG-CDF

BOBASI NG-CDF has significantly revolutionized the life of constituents of Bobasi Constituency. The fund has enabled development of education, health, roads and water infrastructures among other sectors strongly improving the quality of life and enhancing delivery of basic services to the citizenry.

### Location of Bobasi Constituency

Bobasi Constituency is geographically located in Kisii County. 


