



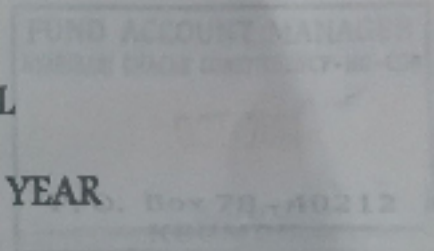

## INTRODUCTION

The NG-Constituency Development Act 2015 stipulates in part 5 section 27 subsection 1 and 2 that the chairperson of the NG-CDFC shall, within the first year of the commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency.

The NG-CDFC shall then deliberate on project proposals from all the wards in and any other projects which the Constituency Committee considers beneficial to the constituency, including joint projects with other constituencies; consider the national development plans and policies and the constituency strategic development plan, and identify a list of priority projects, both immediate and long term, out of which the list of projects to be submitted in accordance with the Act shall be drawn from.

Citizen participation in project planning, management and implementation planning requires the involvement of concerned stakeholders. This includes identifying public concerns and values and developing a broad consensus on planned initiatives. It is also about utilising the vast amount of information and knowledge that stakeholders hold to find workable, efficient and sustainable solutions.

Public participation encompasses a range of procedures and methods designed to consult, involve, and inform the public to allow those that would be potentially affected by a decision or policy to have input into the process. Community participation motivates the stakeholders to work together, recognize the benefits of their involvement and own the projects in their localities.

Stakeholders play a central role in setting up priorities and objectives of development Initiatives in order to ensure relevance and appropriateness. It is important that all stakeholders are involved in the development of projects and not just direct beneficiaries of an initiative.

## ABOUT NG-CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was established under the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act, 2003, amended in 2007 and repealed by the CDF Act of 2013. In 2015, the CDF Act of 2013 was declared unconstitutional and a new Act was enacted in 2015, being the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, NG-CDF Act, 2015. The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is under the Ministry of Devolution and Planning.

The Constituency Development Fund (CDF) was introduced in Kenya in 2003 with the passage of the CDF Act 2003 by the 9th Parliament of Kenya which was repealed in 2013 by the CDF Act 2013. The CDF Act provides that the government set aside at least 2.5% of its ordinary revenue for disbursement under the NG CDF program.

The fund was designed to support constituency-level, grass-root development projects. It was aimed to achieve equitable distribution of development resources across regions and to control imbalances in regional development brought about by partisan politics. It targeted all constituency-level development projects, particularly those aiming to combat poverty at the grassroots and entrench equitable distribution

of development.

The objective of the Fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government development Agenda at the constituency level.

The NG-CDF program has facilitated the putting up of new water systems, health and education facilities in all parts of the country, including remote areas that were usually overlooked during funds allocation in national budgets.

#### ABOUT NYARIBARI CHACHE NG-CDF

NG-CDF Nyaribari Chache has significantly revolutionized the life of constituents of Nyaribari Chache Constituency. The fund has enabled development of education, health, roads and water infrastructures among other sectors strongly improving the quality of life and enhancing delivery of basic services to the citizenry.

#### Location of Nyaribari Chache Constituency

Nyaribari Chache Constituency is geographically located in Kisii county. It borders Bobasi, Nyaribari Masaba, Bonchari and Kitutu Chache south constituencies. Administratively, Nyaribari Chache Constituency is comprised of 6 electoral wards namely: Kisii central, Bobaracho, Birongo, Kiogoro, Ibeno and Keumbu wards.

#### Location of the NG-CDF office

Currently the NG-CDF Office is housed in a rented office at Keumbu social hall, Keumbu town. The construction of the constituency office is ongoing at Keumbu town, 100m away from Keumbu social hall.

The area Member of County Assembly should also hold consultative meeting with all the stakeholders to ward off duplication, double funding or concentration of similar of projects in one locality.



Following the foregoing, it was concluded that;


- Frequent development forums should be held to give the public information concerning the development initiatives being undertaken by all the development partners and the various funding agencies.
