MIN: 01/11/2019 Prayer and opening remarks.

The meeting started at 11: 00 a.m with a word of prayer from Pacificah Okumu. Chairman then read the agenda of the day which were deliberated. He proposed that the meeting be dedicated only to deliberation of projects to be funded in the 2019/2020 financial year of which Ksh 137,367,724.14 has been allocated to the constituency.

The basis of deliberation of the budget proposal shall be based on the ward meetings report of public participation meeting done in October 2019, the current status of ongoing projects and projects proposals submitted to office.

MIN: 02/11/2018: Ward Meeting Report

The secretary read the ward meeting report to the committee. Committee discussed the report and agreed that the report was factual and agreed that it reflected the true records of the ward meetings which were held during the month of October 2019. It was adopted and approved for inclusion in the project proposal of 2019/2020.

MIN: 02/11/2019: Prioritization of projects to be funded in 2019/2020 financial year.

The committee agreed that the criteria of identifying projects shall be status of projects and ward meeting report.

The ongoing projects shall be given precedence before identifying new projects in the ward report.

Fund Account Manager guided members in reading a circular from the head office on the guidelines required in submission of 2019/2020 he noted that the constituency had been allocated Ksh.137,367,724.14 which the committee is to budget based on the guidelines.

Chairman informed members that the proposal is required to be submitted by as soon as possible but a soft copy to projects department is supposed to be submitted before hard copy is forwarded after the proposal has been entered in the NG-CDFMIS Portal. This the first time the proposal is being submitted through the portal.

The NG-CDF Committee discussed the circular NG-CDFB/CEO/BOARD CIRCULARS Vol.II (014) dated 24th September 2019 and made the following resolutions:

- That in prioritizing of projects the ongoing projects will be given precedence.
- That National Government function projects be funded as per NG-CDF Act 2015 Amended 2016
- It was agreed devolved proposed by public but fall within devolved functions be forwarded to County for consideration.
- As per the NG-CDF Board Circular, the projects to be funded shall be only those that are in respect of works
 and services falling within the functions of the National Government under the constitution, and must be
 community based in order to ensure that the benefits are available to a widespread cross-section of the inhabitants
 of a particular area.

The CDF Committee discussed the report from ward forum and made the following resolution:

a) Purchase of School Buses.

School one bus each. It was agreed that the buses be purchased one-off in the current financial year, it was agreed that the government contracted price be basis of allocating fund for the bus purchase. Based on the government contracted rates, committee allocated Ksh.7,200,000 for each of the bus, these does not include insurance premium. The beneficiary school will pay for the recurrent insurance expenditure.

b) Prioritization of projects to be funded

NG-CDF Committee deliberated on the project proposal and agreed to implement the following projects in 2019/2020:
