The committee agreed that the criteria of identifying projects shall be status of projects and ward meeting report. Ongoing projects shall be given precedence before identifying new projects in the ward report.

Tund Account Manager guided members in reading the circular from the head office on the guidelines required in submission of 2022/2023 he informed members that the constituency has been allocated Ksh. 143,087,603 in the financial year 2022/23. Committee is expected to prepare the budget based on the guidelines in the circular.

Chairman informed members that the proposal is required to be submitted as soon as possible but a soft copy is to be submitted for review by projects department before a signed hard copy is forwarded after the proposal has been entered in the NG-CDFMIS Portal. The proposal is to be submitted through the NG-CDF portal.

The NG-CDF Committee discussed the circular NG-CDFB/CEO/BOARD CIRCULARS Vol.II (020) dated 15th December 2022 and made the following resolutions:

- That in prioritizing of projects the ongoing projects will be given precedence.
- That National Government function projects be funded as per NG -CDF Act 2015.
- As per the NG-CDF Board Circular, the projects to be funded shall be only those that are in respect of works and services falling within the functions of the National Government under the constitution, and must be community based in order to ensure that the benefits are available to a widespread cross-section of the inhabitants of a particular area.

NG-CDF Committee deliberated on the ward report and projects status and agreed that the following projects be forwarded for approval to be funded in 2022/2023;

That in prioritizing of projects these ongoing projects shall be given precedence. It was therefore agreed that the following projects be funded in 2022/2023 financial year:

0.1 Constituencies Development Fund

National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is a fund introduced initially in 2003 through CDF Act 2003. The Act provided that the government sets at least 2.5% of its ordinary revenue for disbursement under CDF program. It is a precursor of current devolved functions through the counties. The fund is designed to support development at constituency level. It is aimed to achieve equitable distribution of development resources across regions to control imbalances in regions brought about by partisan politics. It targets projects which can be felt by a larger majority i.e education, security and other projects which fall within national Government function as stated in the fourth schedule of the constitution etc.

0.2 Kitutu Chache South NG-CDF

Kitutu Chache North Constituency is an electoral constituency in Kenya. It is one of the constituencies in Kisii County located in Kisii Central District. It was created after promulgation of The Kenya Constitution (2010) which provided for creation of additional 80 new constituencies. It was split from the former Kitutu Chache Constituency before the 2013 General elections.

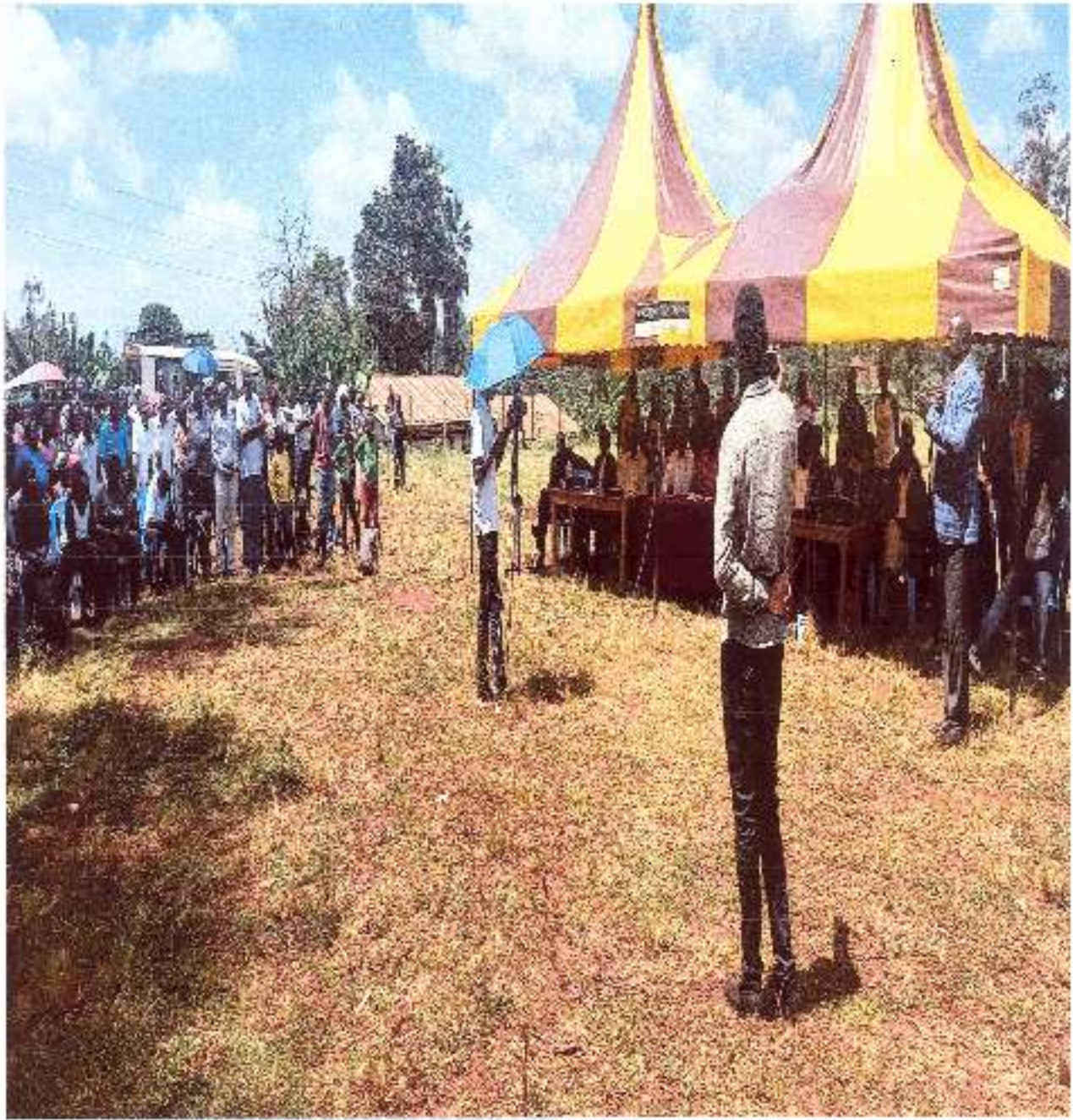

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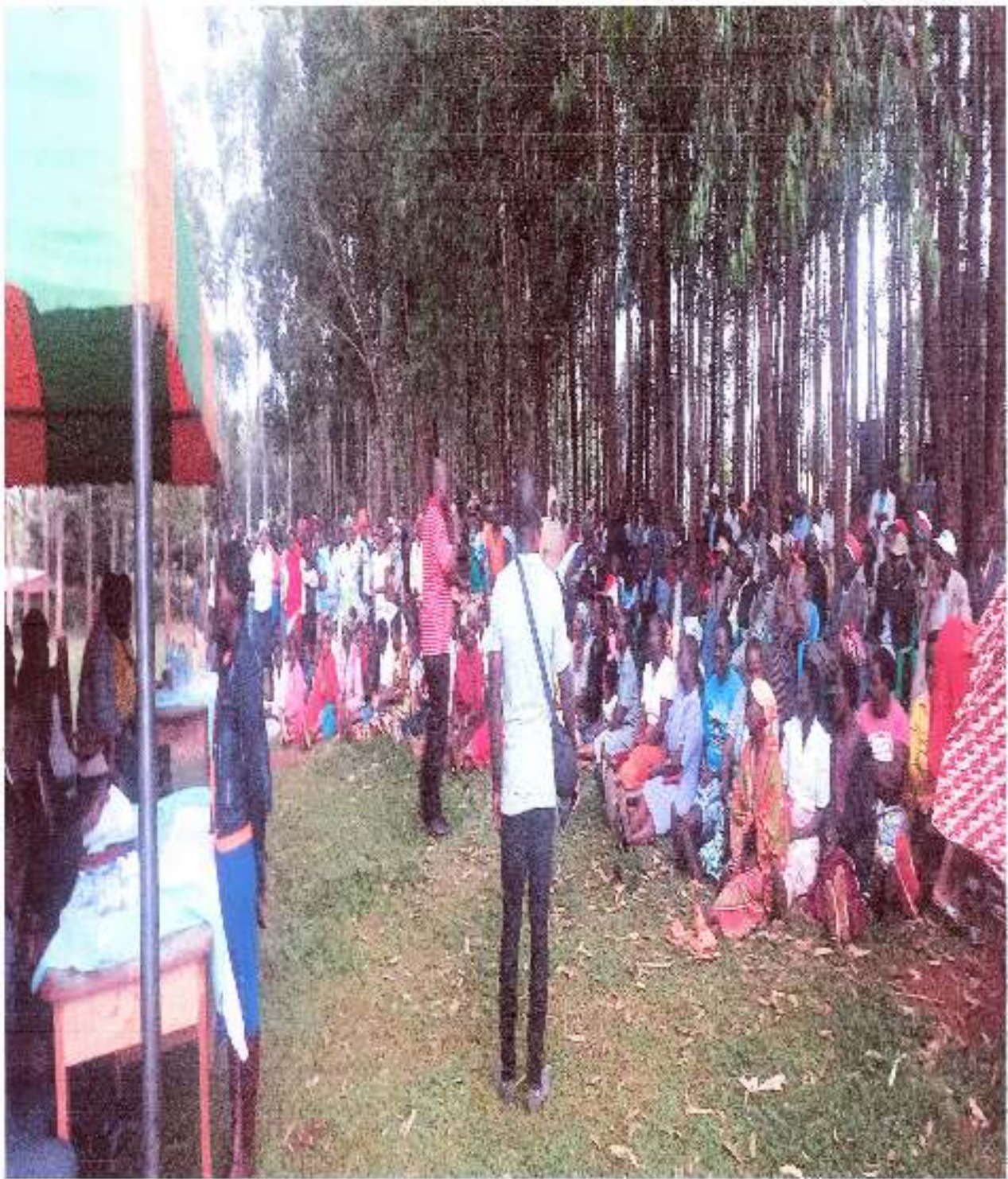

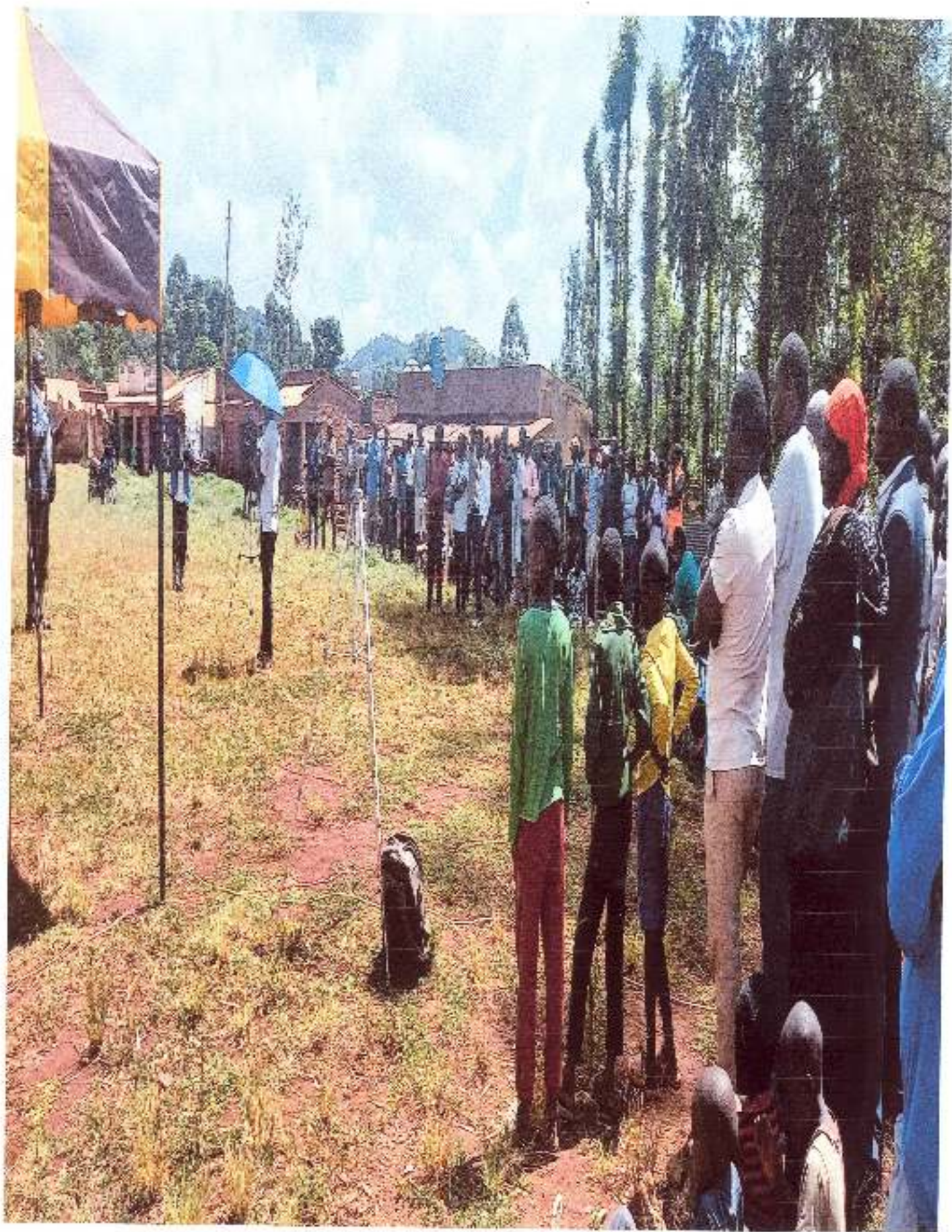
