MIN NG-CDFC/KIBRA/3.0/2020 MATTERS ARISING

Kibera Secondary school is ongoing well, ablution block going on. The rump roofing has been done. It's very impressive. The team will visit with the engineer to verify. Kibera secondary, Upper hill and police housing all to be evaluated in the following week.

The PMC meeting took place to discuss more on the projects. The PMC meeting will resume on 7th October 2020.

Capitol Hill Police Station: Members agreed that letter will be sent to DCC to confirm that the land belong to the government for implementation of project.

Raila Education Primary: The construction of primary school has been agreed upon and the moneys already allocated can be channeled to the classes. Due to the pupils congestion in the classrooms and the poor learning environment in the school, the committee agreed to change the activity from construction of ablution block to construction of one storied building that will increase the number of classroom to safe guard the pupils during this Covid 19 pandemic and in future. There is an existing ablution block that has been uplifted.

Woodley Secondary School: Ground breaking to be done very soon.

The sub county houses: Project is already ongoing and roof works have already done.

Toi TVET: After deliberations, the Kibra NG-CDF committee agreed to open **Toi TVET Center-PMC Account in Kibera Equity Bank**. Pursuant to the NG-CDF ACT of 2015 amended 2016, the committee mandated the Fund Account Manager to write introduction letter to the Equity Bank Manager, Kibera Branch.
