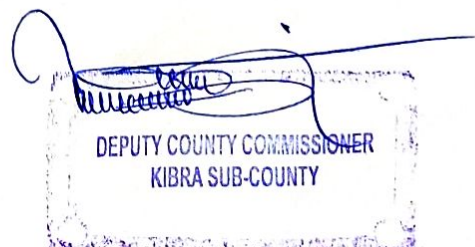
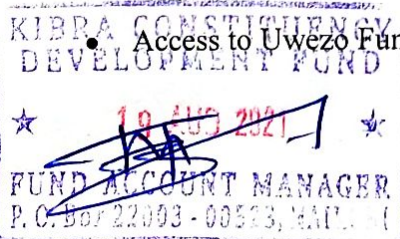

#### **Agenda 1 : Ongoing Projects in Woodley Ward by Kibra NG-CDF**

The following projects are ongoing within Woodley Ward:

- Construction of a perimeter wall at Moi Girls school
- Construction of a secondary school, Woodley Boys school
- Bursary Issuance to needy students from Woodley both from Secondary schools and Universities
- Access to Uwezo Fund by Women and youth



- Construction of a TVET at Toi primary school

## Agenda 2: Proposed Projects for 2021/2022

The following projects were identified by the Woodley Ward Community:

- A road accessing the Maternity Ward at Mbagathi Hospital.
- A public toilet at Mbagathi Hospital
- Market Sheds at Mbagathi – Kenyatta Market
- Market Sheds at Othaya Market
- A secondary school to be done at Jamhuri primary school and it should be named Woodley Boys Secondary school. The school construction is currently ongoing and funds should be prioritized for the completion of the school.
- Electrification in Jamhuri and it's environs, in Ngumo – Security lighting.
- Construction of a Technical Education and Vocational Training (TVET) Centre since the constituency does not have one and the ward has public schools with space. It was suggested that it be constructed at Toi Primary School
- Construction of a perimeter wall at Moi Girls school
- Supply of secondary School desks

## Agenda 3: AOB

Construction of Mbagathi High School was completed and Mheshimiwa Imran Okoth promised to buy desks and computers for the school through NG-CDF.

It was highlighted that there was poor drainage especially in Jamhuri area. It was agreed that the MCA will deal with this issue.
