The Fund Account Manager also took the members through the Board circular ref.NG-CDFB/CEO/BOARD CIRCULARS VOL.11(014) which gives guideline on preparation and online submission of constituency project proposals for the FY 019/020. Priority was also given to ongoing projects while compiling the 019/020 proposals. Reference was also made to the constituency strategic plan and ward meetings report. #### BACKGROUND

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION ABOUT NG-CDF

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) formerly Constituencies Development Fund (CDF), is a fund established in 2003 through an Act of Parliament, the Constituencies Development Fund Act, 2003. The Act was later reviewed through the enactment of the CDF (Amendment) Act 2007, and repealed through CDF Act, 2013. The latter was subsequently succeeded by the current NG-CDF Act, 2015. Projects under this Act shall be Community based in order to ensure that prospective benefits are available to a widespread cross section of the inhabitants of a particular area. The National Government Constituency Development Fund Committee (NG-CDFC) are mandated to discuss on the project proposals from all the wards in the constituency and any other project that the Constituency Committee considers beneficial to the constituency

The primary objective of this fund is to address poverty at the grass root level by dedicating minimum of 2.5% of the Government ordinary revenue to grassroots development.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION ABOUT KASARANI CONSTITUENCY

Kasarani constituency is one of the 17 constituencies in Nairobi County. Up until 2007 elections it has been known as Kasarani constituency. Prior to the 2013 general election Kasarani was split up to form four constituencies: Kasarani, Roysambu Ruaraka and Mathare The constituency is currently represented by Hon. Mercy Gakuya. It is located in the Eastern part of Nairobi, about 14Kms from the City Centre. It has an area coverage of 152.60km² with a population of 200,984 (National Population Census, 2009). It consists of five County Assembly Wards. The table below shows the five wards with the distribution of its population:


