

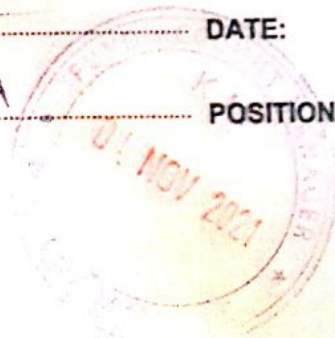

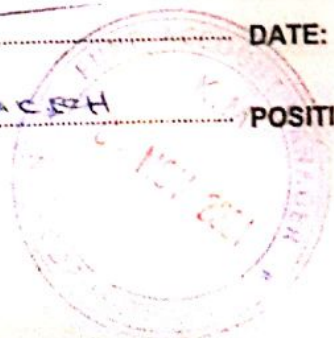

It is a requirement that the public forum be held in 2019/2020 since two years has elapsed. Based on the act, the chairman of the fund in consultation with other relevant government department held public forum in each ward to deliberate on the project priorities for the financial year 2019/2020.

ASSISTANT CHIEF.

RESOLUTION MADE IN THE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION EXERCISE

1. The Udungu society disputes should be solved to enable NGCDF fund projects in the facility. The deputy county commissioner was tasked to ensure the land issues in Udungu society were sorted with immediate effect.
2. Transition of students to secondary schools was to be sorted by establishing new secondary schools in the existing primary schools.
3. The chiefs' offices to be furnish with furniture to improve services to the constituents.

5. Establishing of libraries and laboratories in all schools beginning with secondary schools.
6. Bursary to the Disable in the society should be followed keenly.
