MATHARE CONSTITUENCY WARD MEETINGS REPORT

FOR

THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2022/2023/2024

1.0 Introduction

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund is an initiative by the National Government aimed at promoting equitable socio-economic development at the grass root level. In 2003, the parliament of Kenya passed the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act 2003. The Fund was formed as a devolved fund that was intended to enhance rapid social-economic development at the Constituency level through public participation. In the year 2015, the (CDF) was changed to National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) through an act of Parliament 'NG-CDF Act, 2015' with an intention of aligning the Fund with the Constitution of Kenya 2010.

The NG-CDF Act, 2015 provide a framework for citizens led development to assist the national government in planning and prioritizing the use of its resources. Section 27(1) of the NG-CDF Act 2015 stipulates that, the Chairperson of the Constituency Committee shall, within first year of the commencement of a new parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in Constituency. This is intended to enable the Committee deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency which plays the pivot deliverable for project proposal prioritization. From this backdrop, the Mathare NG-CDFC carried out public forum meetings where the constituents were given an opportunity to decide the projects of their priority. The Forums took due cognisance of the Ward as their strata.

1.2 Methodology

This ward meeting report come into existence as a result of an intense public forums which embraced participatory and direct engagement with Mathare Constituents. The consultative Forums also involved members of the National County Administration, Public learning institution heads and Mathare NG-CDFCs. The area Member of Parliament was also invited in the forums. The Committee collected the proposals through every sub-location representative who formed the basis of the Ward strata. Each representative was required to present the views of the area members which were to be supported as the true projects by at least 3 area residents. Before the start of each of the meetings the NG-CDFC Chairperson and the Fund Account Manager briefed the Constituents on what is required by the Act. They went ahead to specify that the proposed projects will be factored in two financial year period that is 2022/2023 and 2023/2024. The Constituents were also encouraged to continue presenting their needs even after the meetings.

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

2.1 WARD I (Huruma Ward)

The meeting was held at Huruma Social Hall. The NG-CDF committee members urged the community to prioritize the projects that they would like to be prioritized first considering that NG-CDF had very limited funds to serve mega projects that would serve the whole constituency. They were also advised to differentiate National Government projects from the County projects.

The community and their leaders expressed their concern for the following;

Education

- 1.Bursaries They requested the bursaries to be increased to be in position to reach more people. The members of public in Huruma ward made a humble request that we come up with better way of distributing the bursaries.
- 2. The residents of Huruma ward requested building of class rooms at Halama primary school. This is to help decongestion within the public primary school.
- 3. The residents in Huruam ward made a poposal for increment of Daima primary school classrooms. They requested for more classrooms to be built to help to deal with high population of learners.
- 4 The Huruma primary Board of Management proposed the construction of more classes and descent lavatory.
- 5 In Daima primary, its Board of Management also requested for construction of mlore descent toilets as well.
- 6 Daima primary requested for the repair of classrooms and roofing to ensure a condusive learning environment.
- 7. Huruma primary requested for the following;
 - Construction of perimeter wall, and laboratory class as well
 - II. Raising of the perimeter wall.
 - III. Front administration block.
 - IV. 2 tables of 2m in length.
 - V. 24 pieces of teachers' chairs. Science room.

In Huruma secondary, proposals were made that;

1. Roofing to be done.

- 2. Laboratory construction to be done.
- 3. Provision of office tables.
- 4. Pathway construction from the main gate to the school.

Security

The residents of Huruma ward requested for the renovation of chief's office camp to cater for local effective administration.

Sports

The residents of huruma requested for;

- 1. A conducive children's playground.
- 2. Perimeter wall at huruma grounds.
- 3. Requested perimeter wall at huruma play grounds.

RECOMMENDATIONS.

The residents of huruma ward to be provided with the stated adequate social amenities public satisfaction, with the available utilities.

Garbage collection points to be put up to avoid littering the environment

Jonsaga to Mathare north road to be constructed to help in having the area more passable and secure.

The NG-CDF Committee Chairperson expressed his gratitude to the contributions that were received and thanked everyone who had turned up for the meeting. He assured them that as soon as the money is given to NG-CDF they should be ready to front the various PMCs for the projects they had pinpointed so that the projects are supervised well until completion.

2.2 WARD II (Ngei Ward)

The meeting was held at Ngei P.A.G Primary School with attendance from various communities and government leadership and the community. After long deliberations, the following Sectors of concern were put forward by the Ward residents;

Education

- Putting in consideration ngei ward has so many people, they requested their bursaries to be increased.
 They were grateful for transparent way of bursaries' issuing.
- 2. Requested for identification and building of primary school.
- 3. Youths requested for more bursaries for driving.
- One resident asked NG-CDF if there is any way they can start supplying sanitary pads to school going kids.

Security

- 1. Requested for building of assistant chief's office
- 2. Requested for 46 security light to be fixed.

Sports

1. Youths requested fencing of juja house field

RECOMMENDATIONS.

The key needs of the people of Ngei ward, such as building of a primary school and provision of security lights is not worthy ignorance. Therefore, the necessary actions of providing these facilities should be instituted.

2.3 WARD III (Mlango Kubwa Ward)

The meeting was held at Teresa's Primary School with attendance from various community, County and government leaders where they expressed their gratitude for the activity. This, as they affirmed, will enable the projects have strong support of the community. The Constituents urged the NG-CDF committee to consider increasing the amount of bursary amount awarded to the ward since they needed to support more needy students.

The NG-CDF Chairperson pointed out to the residents that his committee had previously maximized the budget amount for bursary. He went on to state that every year there was more and more needs for more money to be allocated but the limiting factor was that NG-CDF had a ceiling to how much can be budgeted for the bursary according to the amount given to any constituency. He however promised that the committee would come up with a good strategy that will see the bright needy students get enough bursaries to sustain learning to completion.

The participants then conclusively prioritized the projects as follows;

Education;

Bursary advertisement to be done vigorously prior to the application date and on the distribution day, the exercise should take a whole day per ward.

Kiboro primary school - more classes and toilets especially for the junior secondary intake that need even furniture and teachers that are not available. A library, kitchen and an administration hall. There was a request to help in the acquisition of a playing field and a way to avoid the garbage from Eastleigh from affecting the learners

St. Theresa girl's primary school - modern kitchen construction, swimming pool renovation, toilets construction, fencing of the school and renovation of the mosque and hall. More storage facilities i.e. water tanks, Gutters, planting of trees, metallic dustbins and the road within the school to be tarmacked or put under cabros

St. Theresa girl's secondary school - construction of a 2 storey school dormitory, naming of the road in the school as Hon. Oluoch lane, additional toilets constructions, gutters in whole school, water tank, planting of trees, metallic dust bins and allocation of bursaries to the most needy students with a negotiation plan from the principal and office of the MP. Also, there was a suggestion for a police container to be put up in the school to help maintain the order.

Environment

On environment, the community members suggested that the administration should enhance more tree planting activities, and in this way creating job opportunities for the youths in areas such as behind St. Theresa girl's secondary school and redeemed gospel church.

Administration.

Matters on administration, there was a suggestion of building a chief's office or putting up a container so that there could be deployment of at least five (5) police officers to cub the increasing insecurity. Enhance roads especially the Mau-mau road. Proper representation of youths in the office of the MP. Also, kambi Nari garbage space should be put under use.

Security

Security being very critical, a suggestion on increased flood lights around the ward, boda boda thieves to be looked into. The rise of street children to be checked as they are used to mug and cause distress to the area residents. Nyumba kumi to be empowered and properly coordinate with the area assistant Chief, chief and police to ensure proper security

RECOMMENDATIONS

Education;

- -Bursary allocation
- -That the modern kitchen should be constructed at St. Teresa's primary to help the school in preparations of meals for the learners so as to encourage proper school attendance and better class concentration
- -That the dormitory at St. Teresa's girl's secondary school be constructed to help the school in admitting more students especially with the ongoing schools transition from primary. This will in turn help with high student uptake from around the community

Security;

-That the ward office at Mlango Kubwa be repaired and refurbished/constructed

2.4 WARD IV (Mabatini Ward)

The meeting was held at DCC ground with attendance from the community, government's representatives and county representatives. The community leaders congratulated the NG-CDF for the work they had done in changing the look of the schools. According to the residents, had gone a long way in improving the education standards and also the hygiene of the students. They also thanked the NG-CDF committee for the initiative to implement projects that are community initiated.

The Ward residents however challenged the committee to continue in the same spirit of improving the schools for their pupils and the security of the remaining shopping areas that had not benefited from the erection of security masts. They left it to the committee to prioritize which shopping areas to help with the security masts and which primary schools to renovate first since the list of schools was very long to have all of them done with the amount given to NG-CDFC.

It was therefore agreed that;

Education

- 1. Identification of land for primary school.
- 2. Wheel chairs for disabled school going kids.
- 3. NYS houses to be renovated and made youths recreational centres.
- 4. Bursaries, they requested bursaries to be increased in numbers.
- 5. PWDs requested to be getting their bursaries in a special way.
- 6. Requested for a public secondary school at undug.

Security

Requested the street lights to be fixed.

RECOMMENDATIONS.

Due to the vital and basic nature of the requirements needed at Mabatini ward, it is deemed much necessary if the solution is made as soon as possible, as per the requests made by the public from that particular ward.

Youths to have an office so that they can be recognized

Have two members of Mabatini youths to represent the ward in the office of the MP

Disabilities to be considered while giving out wheelchairs

2.5 WARD V (Kiamaiko Ward)

The meeting was held at Valley Bridge Primary School with attendance from the community, government representatives, NG-CDF committee members and County officials. They now requested the NG-CDF committee to slot in some modern Library, Borehole, Administration Block, classrooms.

The other concern that was shown was the condition of roads in the area which they complained that during the rainy seasons the roads were becoming impassable and so they needed the NG-CDF committee to consider if the funds were enough to accommodate such. The NG-CDF Chairperson in response said that the national government had promised to work on some of the roads in the constituency and some of the roads were still work in progress. He stressed on the point that the funds given to NG-CDF are very limited considering all the needs of the community in the constituency. He added that the priority projects in all the wards visited so far for the ward meetings there had been

general consensus on prioritizing security, education and markets, which was making it difficult for the committee to think about roads since the funds were very limiting.

It was therefore agreed that the following would be considered for funding for financial year 2022-2023;

Environment

Trees should be planted across the community to assist the community with good beauty and provide fruits some days in the future.

More toilets to be constructed within the ward to help the locals

Administration

Containers is ready and it needs some facilities to complete the office

Youths are being left out and so they need ways to empower them to stop being idle

Contracts to be awarded to Kiamaiko residents as well

Security

Flood lights along all the roads to help cub idle youths during the night
Installation of CCTVs along all roads for referral of any incidences by the police
Construction of all road either tarmacking or cabros to allow free movement of people at all times.

Education Bursary;

- -Bursary distribution committee to use the village elders because they know the most vulnerable students in the community
- -Equality in bursary distribution and not on tribal lines
- -It should be clear on the right people to approach during bursary distribution. Disability inclusion when allocation of bursary is being done

Valley bridge primary school to be given a secondary school and the road leading to it constructed. There should be proper/smooth coordination when a chief refers any student to the MPs office for any financial school support.

Sports

Landlord of Kiamaiko has space to give out for the construction of a youth social hall.

Huruma field to be levelled and the fence to be raised up and football teams to be well known to avoid mixing with thugs.

Introduction of other sports like boxing.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Education;

- -Bursary allocation.
- -Construction of six classrooms for junior secondary at valley bridge primary school

2.6 WARD VI (Hospital Ward)

The meeting was held at Old Mathare Primary School with attendance from the community members, National government administration representatives and the county government officials. Several community members thanked the NG-CDF committee and the NG-CDF listening to their need for help in the area of security in the past and they had since seen a great change since CDF funded the erection of the security mast in the shopping Centre. They however pointed out that some of the masts had gone off.

They talked about having a challenge in consideration of projects in the past, which had made the area remain behind in terms of community development mainly in infrastructure. They however challenged NG-CDF committee to continue in the same spirit since there was a lot that needed to be done in that area for it to catch up with the rest of the country. Through a local community leader chosen at the venue of the meeting, they highlighted the following to be their major concerns:

Education

The public of hospital ward requested for the following to be provided by the NG-CDF mathare;

- 1. Mathari secondary requested for a laboratory
- 2. Mathari primary and mathari requested for school bus

- 3. Mathari primary requested for the floor of class rooms to be done.
- 4. Requested building of library.

Others

1. Renovation N.Y.S office

Sports

- 1.Requested teams to be helped to register for leagues.
- 2 Depot play ground to be made well and have a good drainage.
- 3 During tournaments the price for winner to be increased.

Security

Police station Kosovo requested;

- 1.More tables.
- 2. Computers to ease their work.
- 3. One office to be improvised to full armory.
- 5. Station perimeter wall.
- 6. Cells to be renovated and done in better way.
- 7. Chief's office perimeter wall.

RECOMMENDATIONS.

Hospital ward of mathere constituency is in urgent need social amenities. More so, the police station of Kosovo needs as soon as possible supply of the stated material.

Electricity to be brought back

More water harvesting tanks in schools

Perimeter wall between police post and residents of Kosovo because of security
