- Cost in approving the projects the members also should consider reasonability and value for money.

The Fund Manager thereafter drew members attention to NG-CDF board circular referenced; CDF BOARD/CIRCULARS Vol. I (121) dated 25th July, 2017, Submission of Project proposals for the 2017/2018 financial year which the committee discussed at length. He also informed the members of the NG-CDF Act in relation to projects identification and that the available money for the Financial Year 2017/2018 was Kshs 86,810,344.82.

The Chair informed the sitting that they would use the Ward Reports that had been prepared after

their just concluded needs assessment exercise.



# 0.0 Introduction or Background 0.1 About NG-CDF

#### 1.0 BACKGROUND

2.0 The natio Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was established under the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act, 2003, amended in 2007 and repealed by the CDF Act of 2013. In 2015, the CDF Act of 2013 was declared unconstitutional and a new Act was enacted in 2015, being the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, NG-CDF Act, 2015. The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is under the state department of Planning. The objective of the Fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government development Agenda at the constituency level.

## 2.1 About Banissa Constituency.

Banissa Constituency is an electorate unit in Mandera County. The Constituency Borders Mandera West Constituency to the South and Mandera North Constituency to the East.
