MATTERS ARISING

Committee memmbers discussed various issues that were captured in the previous meeting. Some of the issues that required clarification, and they included projects that were ongoing. The NGCDFC clerkj of works who was present addressed the issues and informed the members as follows.

- 4. Tongaren NG-CDF office Service charter in both English and Kiswahili and suggestion box were put in place.


MIN: NG-CDFC/TONG/94/05/2022: CHANGE OF PROJECT ACTIVITY AT KMTC TONGAREN FINANCIAL YEAR 2021/2022

In 2020/2021 financial year KMTC Tongaren was allocated Kshs. 15Million for renovation activities. Kshs.8, 224,818 was used to renovate six lecture halls and four hostels. The NG-CDF committee resolved to change the project activity for the remaining Kshs. 6,775,182 for renovation of Dining hall, Kitchen, Computer Lab, Library and Administration block reason being the structures mentioned above were assessed by the Public works engineer and found out to be temporary structures and could not be renovated.

The committee instead resolved to undertake the erection of a two storied building in three phases.

- A) Phase 1- ground floor comprising of Library, ICT Lab, two offices, two stores, Three flush toilets for men and one door dedicated for Persons With Disabilities, four flush toilets for ladies and one door dedicated for Persons With Disabilities. The total funds allocated for phase 1 is Ksh 6,775,182 for FY 2020/2021 and Ksh 900000 for FY 2021/2022. The Total amount for phase 1 is Ksh 15,775,182. With this allocation the building will be constructed to the first floor suspended slab. The ground floor will be complete to a usable state.
- B) Phase 2- First floor—comprising of two big lecture halls, Three flush toilets for men and one door dedicated for Persons With Disabilities, four flush toilets for ladies and one door dedicated for Persons With Disabilities. The total engineers estimated cost for first floor is Ksh 11,550,530. With this allocation building will be constructed to the second floor suspended slab. The first floor will be complete to a usable state.

C) Phase 3- Second floor - Comprises of two big lecture halls, Three flush toilets for men and one door dedicated for Persons With Disabilities form



flush toilets for ladies and one door dedicated for Persons With Disabilities Total engineers estimated cost for second floor is Ksh 10,373,790. With this allocation the building will be constructed to completion. The second floor will be complete to a usable state.

D) Included in the engineers estimate (BQ) are the Preliminaries sum of Ksh 800,000 and prime cost and provisional sum of Ksh 2,500,000.

The all project cost according to the engineers estimate and the submitted BQ from the Public Works Office Bungoma County is Ksh 42,069,570.

The committee therefore resolved for the change of activity to be erection of two storey building (Phase 1) ground floor comprising of Library, ICT Lab, two offices, two stores, Three flush toilets for men and one door dedicated for Persons With Disabilities, four flush toilets for ladies and one door dedicated for Persons With Disabilities as tabulated below:-




