MIN 01/08/2020-2021 READING AND CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING Minutes of the meeting dated 19 October 2020 were read through by the NG-CDFC secretary, it was proposed by Samson Kosgey and seconded by stellah Cheptoo as being what were discussed in the previous meeting. ### MIN 02/08/2020-2021 RE-SUBMISSION OF KSHS 5,000,000.


