MIN. NG-CDFC/MWATATE/33/2023/2024-RE-ALLOCATION OF UNSPENT 2022/2023 F.Y's ELIJAH MZAE SECONDARY SCHOOL FUNDS-KSHS. 6,000,000.00

Members were referred to a letter from Mwatate Technical & Vocational College Ref. No. MTVC/M/1/VOL1/205 and Dated 28th August 2023, addressed to Mwatate NG-CDF. That the letter indicated that the entire college building was at risk of collapsing due to uncontrolled massive roof rain waters and a growing gulley at the corner of the building. That the situation could lead to a disaster due to the anticipated el-nino rains predicted by the weather man starting in October, 2023.

Members were informed that funds allocated to Elijah Mzae secondary school for Construction to completion of a 45 students Science Laboratory-Kshs. 6,000,000.00 (2022/2023 F.Y Allocation) had not been expensed as at 6th September 2023.

Members deliberated on the agenda at length and due to the aforementioned threats to the College building, they finally approved the re-allocation of funds to the said project;
