0.0 Background

0.1 About CDF

The constituencies Development Fund was created by the Constituencies Development Fund Act, 2003 with the primary objective of addressing poverty at grassroots level by dedicating a minimum of 2.5% of the Government ordinary revenue to grassroots development and the reduction of poverty. The fund is managed by the Constituencies Development Fund Board (CDFB).

In January 2013, the CDF Act 2003(as amended in 2007) was repealed and replaced with CDF Act 2013 that is aligned to constitution of Kenya 2010. The CDF Act 2013 was yet repealed and replaced with NG-CDF Act 2015. This was further to ensure that the law governing NG-CDF is aligned to the Constitution of Kenya 2010, specifically in compliance with the principles of;

- Transparency and accountability
- Separation of powers and
- Participation of the people
- The new law was also aimed to align the operations of the Fund to the new devolved government structure.

0.2 About Kathaini

Kathiani Constituency is an electoral constituency in Kenya. It is one of eight constituencies in Machakos County. The constituency was established for the 1988 elections.

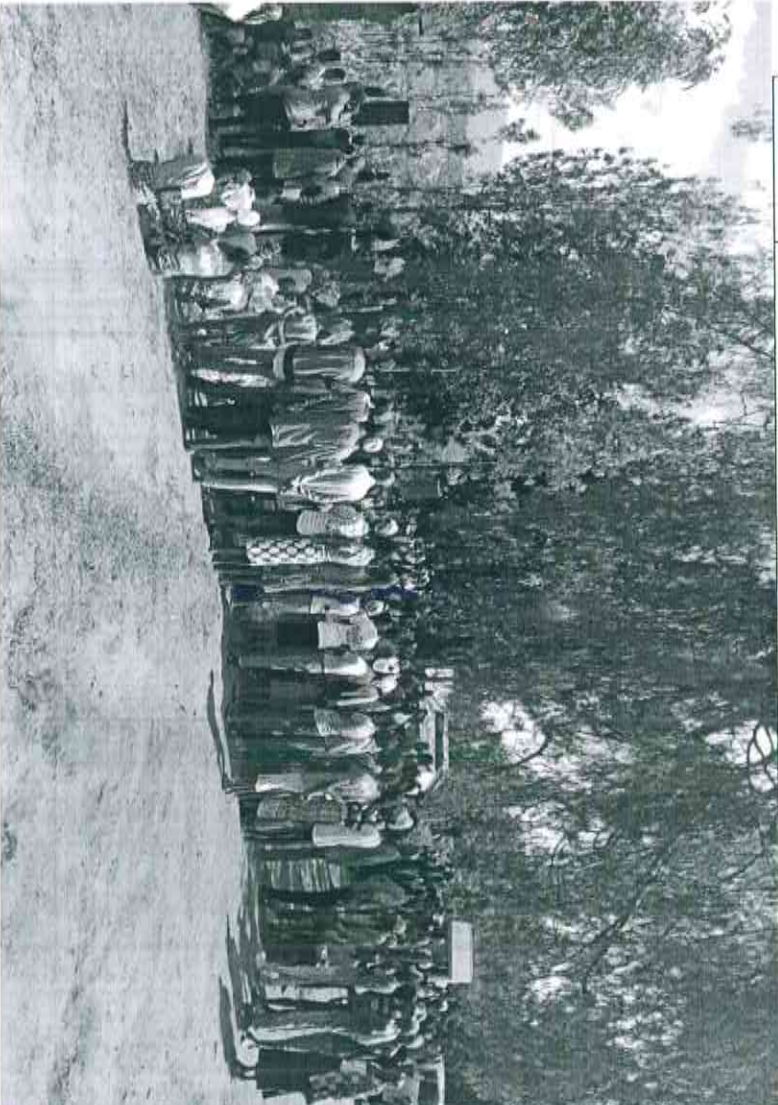

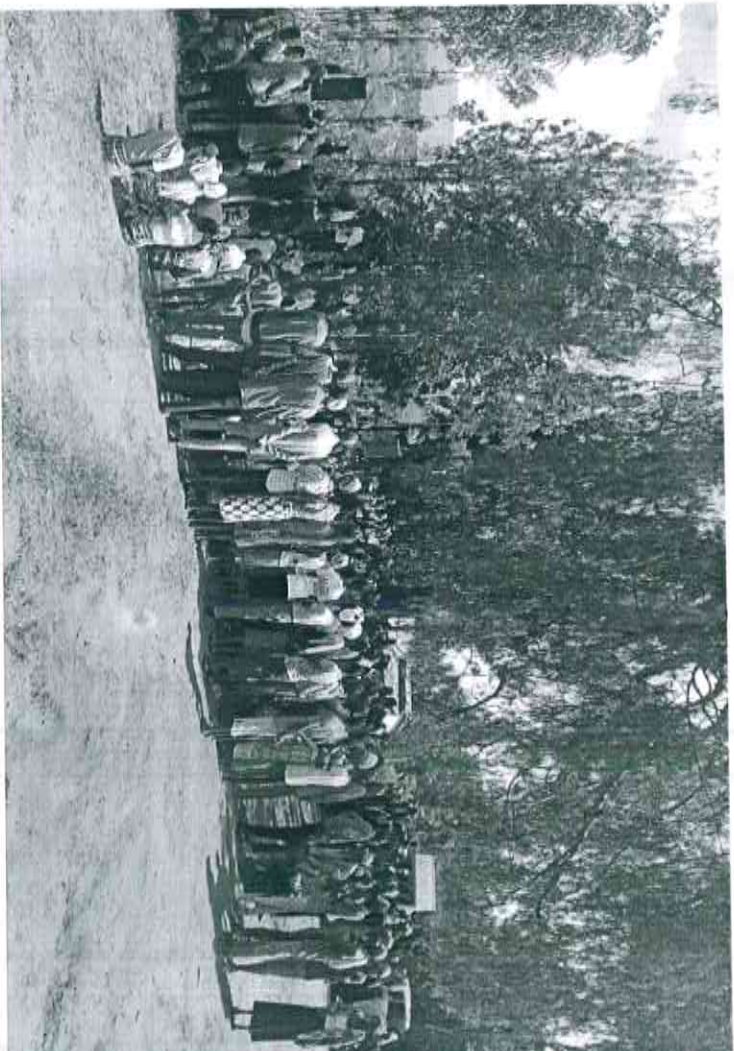
