The following projects have requested for change of project name and activity;

- 1. Uma Primary School Ksh.800,000.00-Renovation of classrooms to construction of administration block. The renovation was done by another donor and therefore their priority is to construct administration block.
- 2. Kitondo Primary School Ksh.500,000.00- Renovation of classrooms to construction of new classrooms. The public works technical report indicated that the classrooms are beyond renovations and therefore the school requires to construct new classrooms.
- 3. Ndituni Assistant Chiefs Office Ksh.700,000.00-change of project name from Ndituni Assistant Chiefs Office to Kiteta Chiefs Office. Kiteta locational committee agreed to construct a chiefs office instead of an assistant chiefs office. Their priority was to build a chiefs office to serve them better in terms of security and service delivery.
- 4. Nthangathini Assistant Chiefs Office Ksh.700,000.00- change of project name from Nthangathini Assistant Chiefs Office to Miau Assistant Chiefs Office. Members agreed to propose funding of the following projects as a matter of priority;

#### 1. Mary Goreti Primary School

The school has six classrooms and they require more. They require additional classrooms as a matter of priority to avoid pupils learning under the trees next year.

#### 2. Kithuia Primary School

The school is young upto standard three and has only three classrooms funded by CDF. They require fourth classroom to accommodate pupils who will be joining standard four next year. If the school is not funded the pupils will learn outside under trees

## 3. Kithangaini Primary School

The school is under pathetic condition. The classrooms do not have doors and windows. The classrooms require plaster and flooring. The department of public health has visited the school and issued a warning letter to the school to either renovate the school or it will be closed down because the pupils are infected with jiggers.

#### 4. Mbooni Resource Centre

The project will be implemented at Kikima in Mbooni West sub-county. The objective of the project is to promote social development and a site for the implementation of the constituency innovation hubs-ICT. The ICT Hubs implementation program is a requirement by the board and therefore this project will facilitate and promote the development.



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The following projects were left out due to lack of funds;

1. Mulooni Secondary School - Construction of Laboratory

2. Mukimwani Secondary School - Construction of Staff quarters

3. Kithungo Secondary School - Construction of Dining Hall

4. Kalawa Social Hall - Completion of Hall And Toilet Construction

# MIN: 40/27/11/2018: ONGOING PROJECTS

Members deliberated on the matter and observed that all the ongoing projects were many with an estimated cost of **Ksh.119,356,157.00**. The committee was able to fund projects totaling to **Ksh.60,517,847.25**. The funding of the ongoing projects is fairly distributed within the six Wards of Mbooni Constituency. Due to constraints of funds all ongoing projects could not be funded within this financial year. However Mbooni NG-CDF committee is committed to fund the remaining ongoing projects in the next Financial years as follows; FY 2019/20 Ksh. 35,000,000 and FY 2020/21 Ksh. 23,838,309.75.

- The committee needs to do appraisal on the year's Performance on project
- implementation.
