MIN.TESON.02/01/22 BURSARY REALLOCATION AND PAYMENT

A summary of the beneficiaries;

Secondary schools applicants are a total of 5,040 arriving at Kshs.25, 200,000

University/tertiary applicants are a total of 1.400 arriving at Kshs.7M

Special cases are a total of 140 beneficiaries

Special courses scholarship is a total of 40 beneficiaries

KMTC scholarship beneficiaries are a total of 150 students

The committee approved the payment of bursary to students as per the above breakdown with each student getting kshs 5,000

The committee agreed to meet and issue cheques to principals at St. Thomas Amagoro Secondary on Thursday, and Chamasiri Secondary on Friday

The approved budget 2021/2022 was budgeted as follows;

Tertiary/university 27,500,000

Secondary schools 11M

Special cases 1M

After bursary application from students across the constituency has been done from sub location level to constituency bursary subcommittee, we were able to discover that the highest number of applicants as compared to the approved. Therefore each applicant should get kshs 5,000 as per the vetting and approval of the sub locational bursary committee, resulting to the rise in the secondary bursary need to over kshs 25 million.

The committee therefore deliberated and agreed for request for reallocation of kshs 14 million from tertiary bursary back to secondary bursary .This is aimed at benefiting most students in the local institutions .
