### MIN1/10/BN/NG-CDFC/NOV/2019 - PREAMBLE

The meeting was called to order at 12:45PM and the chairman welcomed members to the meeting he then requested Mr. Joseph Kesa to open with a word of prayer.

## MIN2/10/BN/NG-CDFC/NOV/2019- READING OF PREVIOUS MINUTES

The secretary read through the previous meeting minutes and thereafter it was proposed by Joseph Kesa and seconded by Rodah Toroitich as true minutes to be adopted.

### MIN3/10/BN/NG-CDFC/NOV/2019 - MATTERS ARISING

\* Members wanted to know if the re-allocation request has been send for approval by NG-CDF Board Nairobi.

The manager informed members that the request has been sent.

\* Members also wanted to know whether payments of staff gratuity and approved request for emergency funds have been made.

❖ The manager confirmed to members that all approved payments have been made.

## MIN4/10/BN/NG-CDFC/NOV/2019 - NEW NG-CDF OFFICE FINAL ACCOUNTS

The members went through the final accounts for the construction of the NG-CDF Office prepared by county public works quantity surveyor. It was established that there were various works and materials of the project which exceeded the quantities in the signed contract as

- i. Excavation exceeded the estimates due to steep terrain of the site
- ii. Sub-structure wall exceeded due to the depth of the foundation
- iii. Ground beam provided to break the several number of courses on the sub-structure wall
- iv. Roofing materials under estimation of both the roofing hollow metallic sections and the
- v. Reinforcement bars size and spacing on the 1st floor suspended slab changed from the D-8 to D-10 with the advice of the structural engineer
- vi. Change of windows material specifications from steel casement to aluminum
- vii. Change of electrical accessories material specification from plastic to brass
- viii. Change of tile specifications
- ix. Change of ceiling board specifications from the ordinary chip board to gypsum type
- x. Change in size and material specifications in some of the doors
- xi. Omission of the, spiral stairs, gutters and down pipes in the bill of quantities

It was also noted that the work done so far is worth Kshs. 43,925,684 hence exceeding contract sum by Kshs. 6,124,416 accounting for 16% variation. The members also discussed the proposed works which are yet to be done costing Kshs. 5,569,751. They found that if all the proposed works are to be done they will cost a total of Kshs. 49,495,435 which will translates to 25% variation of the total contract sum.

# MIN5/10/BN/NG-CDFC/NOV/2019 - APPROVAL OF THE NEW NG-CDF OFFICE COST

Having gone through the final accounts for NG-CDF Office construction and variation in various sections of the structure it was found that there was a substantial variation over the contract sum of Kshs. 37,801,268. The members were informed that the contractor had already undertaken most of the works exceeding the contract sum by Kshs. 6,124,416.

The pending works include; mechanical works, part of civil works, part of electrical works, first floor office partitions, ramp accessing the first floor and the spiral stairs for the exits at each end of the structure. The members deliberated at length and finally resolved to approve a variation of maximum 21% of the contract sum which translates to Kshs. 7,938,266.28 which they agreed to cover up to mechanical works to allow the office to be occupied. The first floor office partitioning, part of civil works, part of electrical works, ramp and stairs to be considered later as separate contracts with the approval of funds by the NG-CDF Board.

### MIN6/10/BN/NG-CDFC/NOV/2019 - PAYMENTS

1. The members having approved the variation, they were also informed that Belion Hardware and Building Contractors Limited had already undertaken works worth Kshs. 6,124,416 and has requested to be paid the same. The works include; floor and wall tiling, aluminium window frames and one way window panes, electrical works, doors, ceiling and fixing of gutters and down pipes.

It was resolved that the contractor Belion Hardware and Building Contractors Limited be paid Kshs. 4,000,000 and the rest be paid after completion of the mechanical works.

2. The members were informed that S&G Contractors Limited undertaking construction of the septic tank and the two masonry tanks of capacities 150M3 (one hundred and fifty cubic meters) and 50M3 (fifty cubic meters) has requested payments for the works done so far totaling Kshs. 1,340,240 for the septic tank which is certified complete.

The members inspected the said works to with the assistance of office clerk of works and were satisfied and resolved to approve the payment of Kshs. 1,340,240 to S & G Contractors Limited as per the certificate raised.

3. The members were also informed that Kibartu Construction and Supplies Limited contracted for external civil works raised first payment certificate worth Kshs. 2,307,800 for site clearance, cutting and filling of the proposed parking and carriage way.

#### Resolution

The members confirmed the progress of the works through office works officer and later scrutinized the payment certificate raised. They noted that quantities of cut materials claimed by contractor were higher compared to surveyor's estimates i.e 2600 cubic metre against 1350 cubic metre. After discussing at length members resolved to pay thirty percent (30%) of the raised certificate i.e Kshs. 692,340 to Kibartu Construction and Supplies Limited until the a common position is agreed on volumes to avoid stalling of works.

## MIN7/10/BN/NG-CDFC/NOV/2019 -PROJECT PROPOSAL FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2019-2020

The manager informed members that the constituency has been allocated Kshs. 137,367,724.14 for financial year 2019/2020. Out of this total amount, emergency is Kshs. 7,198,241.38. The members resolved to allocate the remaining funds to ongoing projects as per priorities given by the community after the statutory deduction. However, all the prioritized projects will not be considered in this financial year because of the ongoing construction of NG-CDF Office.
