

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The National Government Constituency development fund Act 2015 section 27 stipulates that the chairman of the Constituency committee shall, within the first year of the commencement of a new parliament and at least once every two years thereafter convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency.

It is therefore the role of the community as whole to priorities the projects and set development agenda for the constituency.

1.1 ABOUT NG-CDF




The National Government Constituency Development Fund (NG-CDF) formerly Constituency Development Fund (CDF), is a fund establishment in 2003 through an Act of Parliament, the CDF Act, 2003. The act was later reviewed by CDF (Amendment) Act 2007 and repeal by CDF Act, 2013 which was subsequently succeeded by the current NG-CDF Act, 2015.

The main purpose of the Fund is to enhance infrastructural and socio-economic development at the grass root level in order to reduce poverty by dedicating a minimum of two and a half (2.5%) of all National Government Share of Annual revenue towards Community Projects identified at constituency level.

1.2 ABOUT EMBAKASI WEST NG-CDF

Embakasi West Constituency is one of the seventeen (17) constituencies in Nairobi County. Before Embakasi West Constituency was established, it used to be part of Embakasi and Kamukunji Constituencies. It has four wards, Umoja One, Umoja Two, Mowlem and Kariobangi South/Uhuru.

The Embakasi West CDF office is located along Mtindwa Road few meters from the Umoja 1 Market.
