MIN/1/12/2017 READING AND CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MEETING'S MINUTES

MIN/2/12/2017 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE PREVIOUS MEETING'S MINUTES

- The chairperson to the committee led the team in convening the ward open forums in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters
- The ward meetings were held in Kuku, Kimana, Rombo, Imbirikani/Eselenkei and Entonet wards
- The chairperson was accompanied by the area member of parliament, the Fund Account Manager and the committee members
- The public gave their views on the development agenda. Key crossing cutting issues of gender mainstreaming, environment, FGM, bursaries and HIV AIDS were highlighted.
- More emphasize was on women, youth and persons living with disabilities to apply for contracts as the law stipulates 30% of the tenders to go to this special group. The wananchi were requested to apply for bursaries in the coming year
- The wananchi came up with a basket of projects





- The budget allocation for the constituency had reduced from the earlier to Ksh.86,810,344.82 with Ksh. communicated Ksh.101,416,090.34 4,568,965.52 as the emergency.
- The recruited NGCDFC staff had already signed their contracts.

MIN/3/12/2017 PROJECT PROPOSAL FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2017/18

✓ The Fund Accounts Manager shared circulars from the NG-CDF Boar on Financial year budget ceilings for each constituency and guidelines for preparation and submission of project proposals for board approval.

✓ Section 6(1) of the NG-CDF Act provides that, " the Board shall with the approval of the relevant committee of the National Assembly, allocate funds for every constituency in each financial year in accordance with section 34' Further, section 34(1) of the Act states:- "the budget ceiling for each constituency shall be the amount specified in Section 4(1) divided equally among all constituencies subject to provisions of section 8(1) and 23(1)

✓ Kajiado South allocation for FY 2017/18 is Ksh.86,810,344.82 the allocation

includes Ksh. 4,568,965.52 as the emergency fund

✓ In the FY 2017/18, the constituency was supposed to fund the Constituency innovation hubs at Ksh. 4,677,027.20 and also mandatory was the constituency strategic plan

Sect ion 53 of the NG-CDF Act states; "The constituency Member of National Assembly shall, in consultation with the Constituency Oversight Committee at least twice in every financial year, and upon giving notice of at least fourteen days, convene public forums for purposes of—

- (a) Mobilizing and sensitizing the respective target groups on any matter related to the Fund; and
- (b) Soliciting views, opinions and proposals from the public in regard to the Fund and presenting the views and opinions to the National Assembly;
- (4) The public may in the public forums above -
 - (a) Make recommendations to the Constituency Committee for the better implementation of projects undertaken under the Act:
 - (b) Witness the commissioning of projects and issuance of cheques and other disbursements by the Constituency Committee; and
 - (c) Express their views on the implementation of the Fund:
 - ✓ In Kajiado South, the project identification process was done from the constituency, the ward and the locational level. The Area MP, committee chairperson, and NG-CDFC members held meetings in all administrative levels
 - ✓ The members went through the minutes from all the wards (locations) and noted all the proposed projects by the communities
