MIN 5/ NG-CDFC/MLD/23/10/24 REALLOCATION OF FUNDS/CHANGE OF ACTIVITIES

The fund account manager informed the committee the issue of re-allocation of Shomani Girls secondary school dormitory project funds. In the financial year 2023-2024, the NGCDF Committee funded construction of 300 capacity dormitory at the school. The project was to facilitate admission of form ones in January 2024. Due to delay in disbursement of funds, the project did not take off in time. In the meantime, the school management through the head teacher have approached the office to change the project from construction of a dormitory to construction of an administration block.

The reasons for change of activities are;

- The school did not admit four (4) streams of form ones in January 2024 as anticipated. Therefore the existing dormitories are adequate
- There will be no form ones admission in 2025 because of the curriculum change.
 The next admission will be in 2026 CBC grade 10. At the same time, the school will
 have relieved some facilities through candidates in 2024, and candidates in 2025,
 who will clear school, and therefore more space in the dormitories for admissions
 in 2026.
- Construction of an administration was the schools priority number two (2) during
 the financial year 2023-2024 project request. Currently, the school have partitioned
 two classrooms to serve as offices and staffroom. With a new administration block,
 the school will relieve the two classrooms to be utilized by the students. The
 administration block will create a good working environment for the teaching staff,
 and a better management of the school.
