

1.0 Introduction or Background

1.1 About NG-CDF

The NG- Constituencies Development Fund (NG-NG-CDF) is established under the NG-CDF Act 2015. The Primary objective was to address Poverty Alleviation by dedicating at least 2.5% of annual ordinary Government revenue for development purposes at the grassroots level.

1.2 About Uriri Constituency

Uriri Constituency is one of the Eight constituencies that make up Migori County. Most inhabitants engage in sugarcane and tobacco farming. The population of the Constituency is about 130,000 people and approximate area is 1310 square kilometers. It borders other 3 constituencies as follows, Awendo Constituency to the North, Migori Constituency to the East and Nyatike Constituency to the South. There are 5 political wards, namely;

- i) West Kanyamkago Ward,
- ii) South Kanyamkago ward,
- iii) Central Kanyamkago ward,
- iv) North Kanyamkago Ward,
- v) East Kanyamkago Ward.
