#### MIN 3/30/5/2022: MATTERS ARISING

Progress on Irong Chief's office- the case still in court.

Foot Bridge at Kewapsos-ongoing.

Kewapsos Primary School- reported cracks are huge affecting four classes. Cracks are as a result of the unstable soils with poorly done foundation. Committee to visit the school to assess and report on the way forward because renovations will not solve the structural defects.

FAM and DA attended the workshop in Mombasa. The workshop was on procurement, financial reporting and Human Resource issues. FAM to present to the committee during the next PMC and CDFC training.

Bursaries for both tertiary and secondary schools have been disbursed as approved. The allocation for form one students are yet to be disbursed. The office is still receiving forms. The funds to be released as soon as all the forms have been received.
